The challenges we face are multifaceted. Extreme poverty, hunger, and inequality persist, while global emissions soar to unprecedented levels. In Europe, where progress on SDGs had already stalled since 2020, the multiple crises that ensued have only deepened inequalities and impeded our path towards sustainable development.

It's essential to focus our collective efforts immediately on leadership that can inspire action and advocate for truly sustainable and fair development. Enactus UK & Ireland is poised to be at the forefront of this movement, harnessing the passion, energy and creativity of our young leaders to drive meaningful change in our communities and beyond.

We take pride in the participation of over 4000 young people in our programme this year, with 65 active teams nationwide. Our members have devoted countless hours to develop and implement projects that have positively impacted over 15,000 people across the UK and Ireland.

At Enactus, we create impact through young people by empowering them to become changemakers and leaders in their communities. This year, 4000 young entrepreneurial spirits used our platform to create and develop over **200** social impact and social enterprise projects addressing the most urgent global needs and working towards creating a better more sustainable world for us all.



Nitelight Enactus TU Dublin

Nitelight is a mobile app for safer nightlife, offering real-time location tracking to connect friends, an AI chatbot for support, and venue ratings for safety. It aims to enhance security and reduce anxiety in nightlife settings, empowering users to make informed decisions and fostering a more inclusive environment.

Carte Enactus Sheffield

Carte enhances the lives of adults with learning disabilities through collaborative art therapy workshops. Participants create unique artwork, which is transformed into diverse products, fostering a sense of accomplishment and empowerment.

Seeds for Thought Enactus Southampton

Seeds for Thought aims to boost fresh vegetable access for primary school children in deprived areas by offering direct access and sustainable farming education. They utilise hydroponics to reduce environmental impact while promoting healthy eating habits and inspiring STEM interest among children.

Souper Fresh Enactus TCD

Souper Fresh produces eco-friendly soups by utilising surplus whey from cheesemaking instead of traditional stock, thereby reducing energy usage and costs while mitigating environmental concerns associated with conventional soup production methods.

SPOTLIGHT: Sodexo Stop Hunger

Enactus UK & Ireland launched an innovation challenge in partnership with the Stop Hunger Foundation to promote community development around reducing food insecurity and empowering women.

Through the competition, **26 new and existing Enactus projects** were accelerated, with the overall winners securing funding and industry-level support from Sodexo to enhance and expand their impact within local communities. **12 Sodexo employees** volunteered to mentor and support teams to accelerate their impact further.

SPOTLIGHT: Amazon BEN

For the third year running, Enactus UK & Ireland and Amazon's Black Employee Network (BEN) have collaborated to bring the "Share Your Voice" Challenge to the Enactus student network.

30 students from all across the country who identify as BAME (Black, Asian, Minority, Ethnic) came together at Amazon's offices in Manchester for a day of collaboration and competition; developing and presenting their ideas on Diversity and Inclusion in recruitment and the workplace.

We know that business collaboration delivers a positive impact on business, young people, and the world. We are proud to work with **300+** mentors, volunteers, and coaches who collaborate with Enactus UK & Ireland to create impact both <u>ON</u> and <u>THROUGH</u> young people. This accelerates our joint impact on the SDGs through longer-term meaningful engagement opportunities whilst simultaneously providing a professional development opportunity for the coach.



Our experiential Coach Programme supercharges participants' professional development through immersive application, skills-based engagement, social learning, and network building.



Coaches are paired with University teams strategically. This could be based on **skills required, region** or in line with **talent acquistion, DEI** and **social mobility** strategies.



Coaches meet with their teams regularly to discuss project and team development. Coaches **practise** their coaching whilst **shaping** ideas and approach to **catalyse** impact.



New this year, our **Coaching Clinics** offer flexible, virtual opportunities for businesses collaboration with Enactus teams. Designed for accessibility and engagement, these sessions foster inclusivity to maximise the impact of coaches.
